- Entry Fees:** Full Show Entry: \$75 for one full table
Proxy fee is \$25 plus the full entry fee. No additional table space is provided for proxy entrants.
Everyone receives one full 8 ft table.
- Entrant Info:** The show hall will open for setup at 7:00am, show starts at 8:00am
All entrants, including proxy showers, are required to fill out an entry form and either email or mail it to the Showholder.
Tables are limited and are offered on a first come first serve bases.
Entry fees are non-refundable.

- Show Rules:** Entrants are asked to limit their show strings to **80 models maximum**, per entrant.
Entrants are limited to 3 models maximum per halter class, 2 entries per class in Performance.
Models may show in 2 divisions only, as applicable (i.e. breed and collectability.)
Tags are required on each model. Breed and Gender on one side, Model's Name and Entrants Initials on other side. Entrants must supply their own tags.
- All **Collectability** class entries must include documentation, and will not be judged if it is missing (NAMHSA requirement.)
 - The classlist has changed from last year. Please review it closely!
 - **OF Breyer Breed Divisions** –There are 3 breed divisions for Traditional and Classic scale models, to try to minimize the huge class sizes.
 - **Breyer Regular Run**
 - **Breyer Special Run** – all but BreyerFest or BreyerWest/MidWest
 - **BreyerFest & BreyerWest/MidWest Special Run Only**
 - Documentation is REQUIRED for these 3 divisions. **Regular Runs** - Model name and year is required. For **Special Runs** - please also include the source (Sears, Tractor Supply, etc) and # produced.

- Breed documentations is recommended for rare or exotic breeds and colors. Classes will be placed 1st-6th and will receive ribbons. Section and overall champs and reserves will be awarded rosettes.

Equines placing first or second will receive NAN cards and be qualified for NAN 2026/2027/2028/2029/2030 and/or be eligible to participate in the Merit Award program.

Judges reserve the right to split or combine and classes as they deem necessary.

Courtesy Rules: Please do not argue with the judges. If you have a question, don't hesitate to ask. The judges' decisions are final!

Please be respectful and act in a sportsman-like manner. Anyone disrupting the show may be asked to leave the grounds without refund.

Please do not touch/pickup or move another entrants' model with their expressed permission. If you break it, you are responsible for paying for it. Please check tags before removing any model from the show tables.

Selling from your table is permitted and encouraged! Please keep aisles clear.

Smoking is not permitted in the building or within 25 feet of the entrances.
Pets are not allowed in the building.

We will break for lunch. You may pre-order Jimmy Johns sandwiches on your entry form, or you may leave the venue to pick up lunch from various nearby restaurants.
